1. What is the most generous act you have ever witnessed or been the recipient of?
2. When you think of all the needs around you, what best describes your attitude and why? (a) overwhelmed, (b) thankful for your own blessings, (c) angry at what you see as an entitlement society, (d) hopeless, (e) compelled to do something.
3. Was there any one thing that you most agreed or disagreed with from Sunday's message? What was it and why?
4. Re-read from the message Acts 4:32-36. What do you find most challenging about this Scripture passage?
5. Acts 4:34 says, 'that there were no needy persons among them.' How does that statement make you feel? Do you feel that is realistic? Why or why not?
6. Read Acts 6:1-7. What does the author, Luke, say about what was happening in the church in this passage? What was decided? What were the results?
7. Reflecting on the message and these passages, if you had the opportunity, what are some ideas you would share with Pastor Kent about how our church could best respond to the needs that arise in our congregation?
8. Pastor Andy Stanley says to 'Do for one, what you wish you could do for everyone.' It was also stated in the message to not let what you cannot do stop you from doing what you can. What do these two sentences mean to you?
9. Pastor Rick Warren said that on his tombstone he would like four words written: "At least he tried." Is there a need of someone in our church that your growth group could try and do something to help?
