2. Why do you think the early church was so unified?
3. One of the earliest challenges to the early church's unity is found in Acts 15.
Take time as a group to read aloud Acts 15:1-23.
 - a. What was the dispute and debate of the early church described in Acts 15?
 - b. What steps did they take to begin addressing the differences?
 - c. Peter, Barnabas and Paul, and James spoke to the issue. Which one was most persuasive to you and why?
 - d. What did the church decide to do as a result of this meeting?
 - e. What was the result of this meeting?
4. How important do you think it is for our church to be unified? Explain your answer.
5. What things make it hard for any church to stay unified?
6. What is one thing you can do to promote unity in our church?
7. For the last 8 weeks we have looked at the healthy habits of the early Christians and the early church. What habit is the most personally challenging for you in your spiritual journey?
8. What challenged you the most in the message from Sunday?
9. You heard a personal testimony today from what pastor described as 'not a perfect Christian', but a 'growing Christian'. What challenged or inspired you in your journey through this testimony about being a 'growing Christian'?
