

QUESTIONS FOR GROWTH GROUP AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. What do you think or people would think is one of the one or two greatest discoveries that were made in the last 100 years? Last 10 years?
2. Do you remember when you or your family first bought something new to society, i.e., microwave, VCR, computer, iphone? How has that discovery impacted your life?
3. What are one or two discoveries you have made in your life that maybe changed your life, family, job, business, etc.?
4. What is one thing from the message Sunday that was most challenging or most difficult to understand?
5. What is one thing from the message that you would like more explanation or that you disagreed with?
6. Read Matthew 23:23-24. Who was Jesus speaking to? Discuss as a group your interpretations and take-a-ways from this Scripture.
7. Read Mark 12:41-43. What did Jesus observe? What did Jesus say about what he saw? What are your interpretations and take-a-ways of this Scripture.
8. Anything to do with money and finances tends to be a difficult subject, especially when it comes to topics of tithing and giving to the church. Despite the difficulty of the subject, I've learned the most about giving and tithing from the example, conversations, and writings of others. If you have been growing in your giving as a Christian, I want to challenge you to share your giving or stewardship journey with the group. Share things like: the struggles you had with the tithing concept...when you felt led to take a step of faith...how your decisions have impacted your life...things you wish you had known but were afraid to ask.
